Offered by GW Nursing

1 Applying to the George Washington University School of Nursing? GW Nursing has negotiated an agreement that guarantees admission, but first you have to meet these criteria.

- Associate's Degree in Nursing received
- Overall GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Nursing GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Pass the NCLEX
- Submit online application before program deadline

2 If you meet the guaranteed admissions agreement criteria, next you will need to provide the following items when you submit your application to GW Nursing.

- Transcripts from all higher education institutions attended
- Two letters of recommendation
- Personal statement
- Copy of your resume
- Scanned copy of valid RN license
