Prepare to drive an industry-specific mixer truck vehicle with two or more axles and a Gross Vehicle Weight (GVW) of 26,001 pounds or more, pulling a vehicle with a GVW of 10,000 pounds or less. Become eligible to take the Motor Vehicle Administration Commercial Vehicle License Class-B Skills Test. Upon licensing, you may be employed as a concrete ready mixed truck driver.

JOB DUTIES

- *Operate a mixer truck in a variety of traffic patterns and on various roads*
- *Inspect and maintain vehicle supplies and equipment, such as gas, oil, water, tires, lights, and brakes to ensure the vehicles is in proper working condition*
- *Report mechanical problems encountered with the vehicle*
- *Present bills and receipts collected for goods delivered or loaded*
- *Read maps and follow written and verbal geographic directions*
