I. Scope and Content

The Cooksey-Jones Collections covers the late nineteenth to early twentieth centuries and consists of sixteen photographs of the Cooksey, Jones, and Jenkins families.

Persons of interest include Thomas A. Jones and Ferdinand C. Cooksey.

II. Provenance

Rita I. Cooksey donated the family photographs and an identification list to the College of Southern Maryland on June 6, 1988.

III. Processing

The photographs were placed in archival quality photographic envelopes and then into acid-free folders and box. Mrs. Cooksey numbered the photographs and identified the subjects. Some genealogical information was provided for each person(s).

1. Mary Anna Jones (1886-1918) married Fredinand Cash Cooksey (1881-1928) in 1915. One daughter, Rita Irene Cooksey (1916-)
2. Frances Irene Jones (1889-1915) married Joseph Hubert Jenkins (1889-1970) in 1913. One son, Joseph Francis Jenkins (1914-1959).
3. Bernadette Emily Jones (1891-1947)
4. Lillian Gertrude Jones (1893-1970)
5. Emma Josephine Jones (1896-1973)
6. Elizabeth Magdalene Jones (1898-) married Robert Thomas Morris (1899-1943) in 1933. One son Robert Joseph Morris (1934-)

The above are daughters of Sarah Emily Goldsmith Jones (1862-1914) and John James Jones (ca. 1853-1908), son of Thomas A. Jones. They are grand-daughters of Thomas Austin Jones (1820-1895) and Jane Harbin Jones (1820-1863).

7. Lillian Gertrude Jones (1893-1970), May Queen at St. Peter's Church, Washington, DC, ca.1913.
8. Sarah Emily Goldsmith Jones (1862-1914), daughter of Alexander and Mary Montgomery Goldsmith. Wife of John James Jones (ca. 1853-1908), who was the sixth child of Thomas Austin Jones (1820-1895) and Jane Harbin Jones (1820-1863).
9. Joseph Hubert Jenkins (1889-1970). Husband of Frances Irene Jones (1889-1915). His wedding picture, 1913.
10. Rita Cooksey (1916-), picture taken in First Communion dress, 1923.
11. Rita Cooksey, picture taken in 1921 in the side yard of the La Plata Maryland, home. Shows dolls and chair in vogue at the time.
12. Rita Cooksey, picture taken at La Plata, Maryland public grade school. About third grade, 1925-1926.
