

Articulation Agreement
Between
College of Southern Maryland
And
Villa Julie College

This Articulation Agreement ("Agreement") is made by and between the College of Southern Maryland, 8730 Mitchell Road, P.O. Box 910, La Plata, MD 20646 and Villa Julie College, 1525 Greenspring Valley Road, Stevenson, MD 21153.

WHEREAS the College of Southern Maryland and Villa Julie College recognize the need and importance of facilitating the transfer of students from the College of Southern Maryland to Villa Julie College as these students pursue their educational goals, and

WHEREAS the College of Southern Maryland and Villa Julie College recognize that to enhance this transition, a formal articulation agreement between the College of Southern Maryland and Villa Julie College should be established, and

WHEREAS the College of Southern Maryland and Villa Julie College have conducted a thorough review of the curricula at the College of Southern Maryland and Villa Julie College in the nursing programs,

Now, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and conditions herein, the adequacy of which is hereby acknowledged, the College of Southern Maryland and Villa Julie College hereby agree as follows:

ACADEMIC AGREEMENTS

- A. A College of Southern Maryland student who completes the requirements for an associate's degree in nursing with a minimum of a 2.8 Grade Point Average (GPA) on a four point scale will be accorded the following by Villa Julie College:
1. The student will have all credits in the articulated program applied to the major in order that the student may complete the additional 31 credits to earn a Bachelor's degree by Villa Julie College physically within the southern Maryland region.
 2. Graduates of the College of Southern Maryland program who have completed the Associate's Degree with a cumulative GPA of 2.8 or higher on a 4.0 scale will automatically be accepted into the baccalaureate program at Villa Julie College. Students whose GPA is

- lower than 2.8 upon entering the baccalaureate program will be provisionally accepted and have one year to raise their GPA to 2.8 or higher.
3. The student's GPA as calculated by the College of Southern Maryland will be fully accepted by Villa Julie College.
- B. Appointed institutional representatives from the College of Southern Maryland and Villa Julie College will agree on course-by-course equivalencies in the above-referenced program to facilitate the transfer of students in that specified program from the College of Southern Maryland to Villa Julie College. The parties will agree on those equivalencies within 90 days of the execution of this Agreement and will set them forth in this Agreement.
 - C. Villa Julie College will offer all of the upper division nursing courses necessary for a student to complete the requirements for a bachelor's degree in nursing, in southern Maryland in every two-year period. At least 25% of those courses will be offered at a designated College of Southern Maryland campus on a face-to-face format, with the instructor physically present on that campus at the same time and place as the student, pending suitable enrollment. The remainder of the courses may be offered in either the same face-to-face format, via web-based distance education, or television based distance education. Students shall not be required to attend any class or course outside of southern Maryland to complete the requirements for their bachelor's degree.
 - D. Appointed institutional representatives at the College of Southern Maryland and Villa Julie College will insure that appropriate personnel in their respective institutions are aware of this agreement, including the admissions and advising staffs, transfer coordinators and appropriate faculty and deans.

STUDENT SERVICES

- A. Students who begin their studies at the College of Southern Maryland will be treated on an equal basis with students who begin their studies at Villa Julie College in regards to the award and distribution of financial aid, campus housing, course selection, registration and all other student services.
- B. The College of Southern Maryland will distribute information regarding this articulation agreement to College of Southern Maryland students interested in pursuing a Bachelor's degree in nursing.
- C. The Financial Aid Offices at Villa Julie College and the College of Southern Maryland will follow a consortium agreement, which specifies the responsibilities of each institution with regard to student financial aid.

MISCELLANEOUS

This agreement becomes effective upon signature by all parties. It shall continue in effect until either party terminates it by written notice to the other party at least sixty (60) days in advance. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the termination shall be of no effect with respect to any person enrolled at the College of Southern Maryland as of the date of the notice of termination until two years after that date, and Villa Julie College will continue to offer upper division courses in southern Maryland, as set forth above, during that period.

Each institution shall be solely responsible for determining whether any reasonable accommodations must be made under any federal, state, or local law protecting persons with disabilities with respect to its courses or facilities and for making such necessary reasonable accommodations available at its sole cost.

Neither the College of Southern Maryland nor Villa Julie College shall discriminate against or harass any student who partakes of the benefits of this Agreement on the basis of gender, sexual orientation, race, age, color, religion, disability or marital status, nor retaliate against any such students for alleging any such discrimination or harassment.

Notices required by this Agreement shall be in writing and shall be sent as set forth below. Either party may, by notice given as aforesaid, change its address for all subsequent notices.




parties. Each party acknowledges that no representations, inducements, promises or agreements, oral or otherwise, other than those embodied herein, have been made by any party.

This Agreement is not intended to create legal rights on the part of any applicant, student, or other third party as a third party beneficiary or in any other capacity.


