- Guaranteed admissions for any CSM student who has earned an A.S. in Nursing with a minimum 2.8 GPA and must have a current unencumbered, unrestricted license as a registered nurse in the state where they are employed as a R.N.
- Grand Canyon will accept up to 90 hours of transfer credits. No more than 84 credits of lower division can be applied to an undergraduate program at Grand Canyon
