# College of Southern Maryland Annual Graduate Transfer Report

## Executive Summary

Each year, the Planning, Institutional Effectiveness, and Research Department (PIER) prepares a report of transfer information of those students who received one or more Associate's degrees and/or certificates in a fiscal year and transferred to another institution within the next academic year.

This report examines the cohort of CSM students who received one or more Associate's degrees and/or certificates in FY2015 and transferred to another institution between August 2014 and May 2016. The report includes a summary of the transfer information, transfers by state and institution, transfers by CSM program of study, and rankings of transfer institutions.

### Highlights of the Report

- Of the 1,228 students in the cohort (received one or more Associate's degrees or certificates in FY2015), 51.5% (632) had transferred to another institution by May 2016.
- When examining the students by the type of institution to which they transferred, 50.2% (617) transferred to four-year institutions, and 1.2% (15) transferred to two-year institutions.
- The 632 graduates who transferred went to 90 different institutions in 27 states and the District of Columbia. Of those,
  - 617 students transferred to 84 different four-year institutions in 27 states and the District of Columbia, and
  - 15 students transferred to 6 different two-year institutions in 3 states.
- Four out of every five students who transferred to four-year institutions (80.1%) enrolled at the following top ten transfer institutions (the number of students transferred and percent of the total who transferred to four-year institutions is shown below) [p. 35]:
  - University of Maryland – University College (219 students, 35.5%)
  - University of Maryland – College Park (80 students, 13.0%)
  - Towson University (73 students, 11.8%)
  - Salisbury University (37 students, 6.0%)
  - St. Mary's College of Maryland (24 students, 3.9%)
  - University of Maryland – Baltimore County (19 students, 3.1%)
  - Chamberlain College of Nursing (12 students, 1.9%)
  - Bowie State University (11 students, 1.8%)
  - Frostburg State University (11 students, 1.8%)
  - University of Maryland – Baltimore (8 students; 1.3%)
- Four out of every five students who transferred to two-year institutions (80.0%) enrolled at the following top three transfer institutions (the number of students transferred and percent of the total who transferred to two-year institutions is shown below) [p. 31]:
  - Prince George's Community College (8 students, 53.3%)
  - Anne Arundel Community College (2 students, 13.3%)
  - Rappahannock Community College (2 students, 13.3%)

- The five programs with the largest numbers of transfers were:
  - Certificate – General Studies Transfer Certificate (224 transfers)
  - Associate of Arts – General Studies (193 transfers)
  - Associate of Science – Business Administration (58 transfers)
  - Associate of Arts – General Studies: Criminal Justice (49 transfers)
  - Associate of Science – Nursing (42 transfers)
