Executive Summary

Each year, the Planning, Institutional Effectiveness, and Research Department (PIER) prepares a report of transfer information of those students who received one or more Associate's degrees and/or certificates in a fiscal year and transferred to another institution within the next academic year.

This report examines the cohort of CSM students who received one or more Associate's degrees and/or certificates in FY2017 and transferred to another institution between August 2016 and May 2018. The report includes a summary of the transfer information, transfers by state and institution, transfers by CSM program of study, and rankings of transfer institutions.

Highlights of the Report

- Of the 1,314 students in the cohort (received one or more Associate's degrees or certificates in FY2017), 55.5% (729) had transferred to another institution by May 2018.
- When examining the students by the type of institution to which they transferred, 54.2% (712) transferred to four-year institutions, and 1.3% (17) transferred to two-year institutions.
- The 729 graduates who transferred went to 96 different institutions in 30 states and the District of Columbia. Of those,
 - 712 students transferred to 86 different four-year institutions in 29 states and the District of Columbia, and
 - 17 students transferred to 10 different two-year institutions in 6 states.
- Four out of every five students who transferred to four-year institutions (82.7%) enrolled at the following top ten transfer institutions (the number of students transferred and percent of the total who transferred to four-year institutions is shown below) [p. 35]:
 - University of Maryland – University College (250 students, 35.1%)
 - University of Maryland – College Park (109 students, 15.3%)
 - Towson University (82 students, 11.5%)
 - St. Mary's College of Maryland (37 students, 5.2%)
 - Salisbury University (33 students, 4.6%)
 - Bowie State University (19 students, 2.7%)
 - University of Maryland – Baltimore County (15 students, 2.1%)
 - University of Maryland – Baltimore (12 students, 1.7%)
 - Chamberlain University (11 students, 1.5%)
 - Frostburg State University (7 students; 1.0%)
 - Grand Canyon University (7 students; 1.0%)
 - Western Governors University (7 students; 1.0%)
- More than half of students who transferred to two-year institutions (52.9%) enrolled at the following top two transfer institutions (the number of students transferred and percent of the total who transferred to two-year institutions is shown below) [p. 31]:
 - Prince George's Community College (7 students, 41.2%)
 - Community College of Baltimore County (2 students, 11.8%)

- The five programs with the largest numbers of transfers were:
 - Certificate – General Studies Transfer Certificate (236 transfers)
 - Associate of Arts – General Studies (227 transfers)
 - Associate of Science – Business Administration (87 transfers)
 - Associate of Arts – Arts and Sciences (65 transfers)
 - Associate of Science – Nursing (57 transfers)

Figure 1. Percent of All Transfers by Institution Location and Type

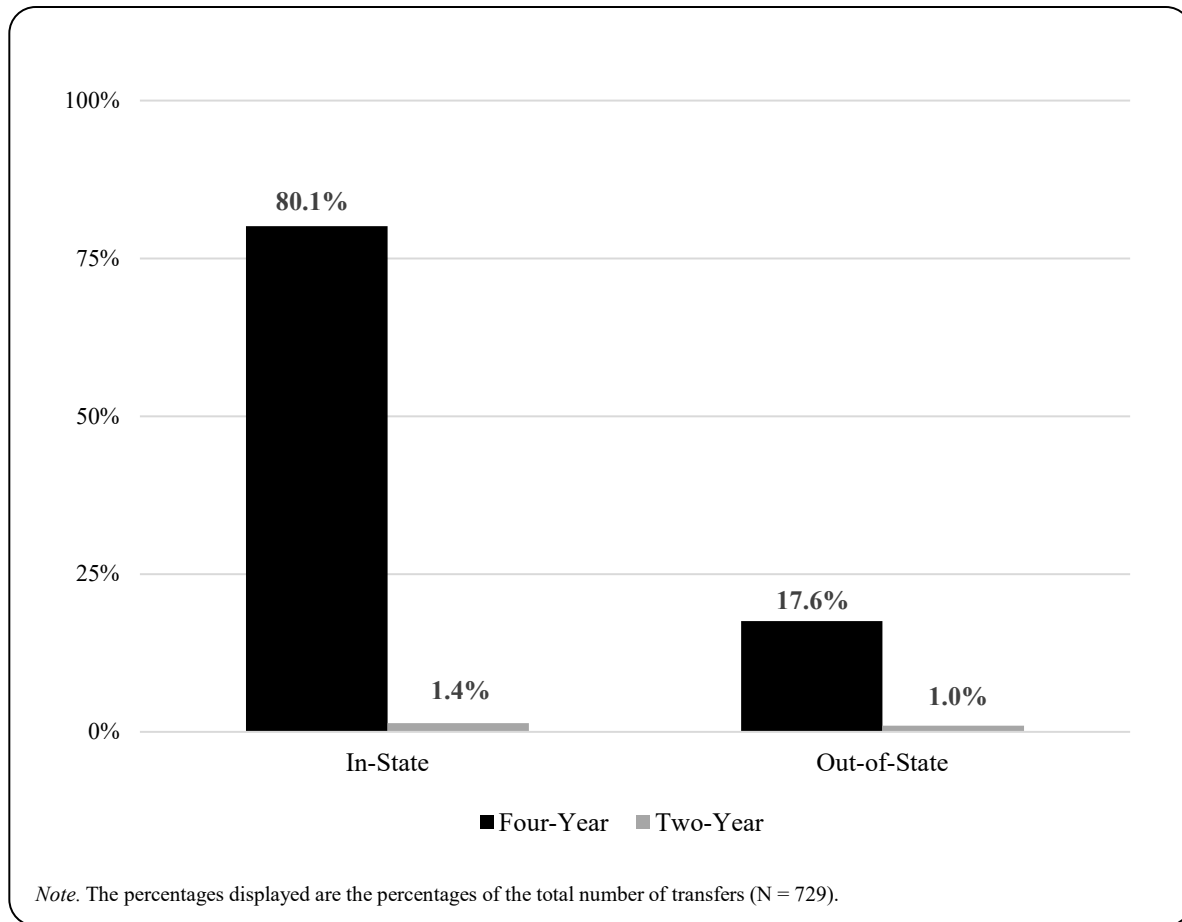

Figure 2. Percent of Transfers to Public Institutions by Institution Location and Type

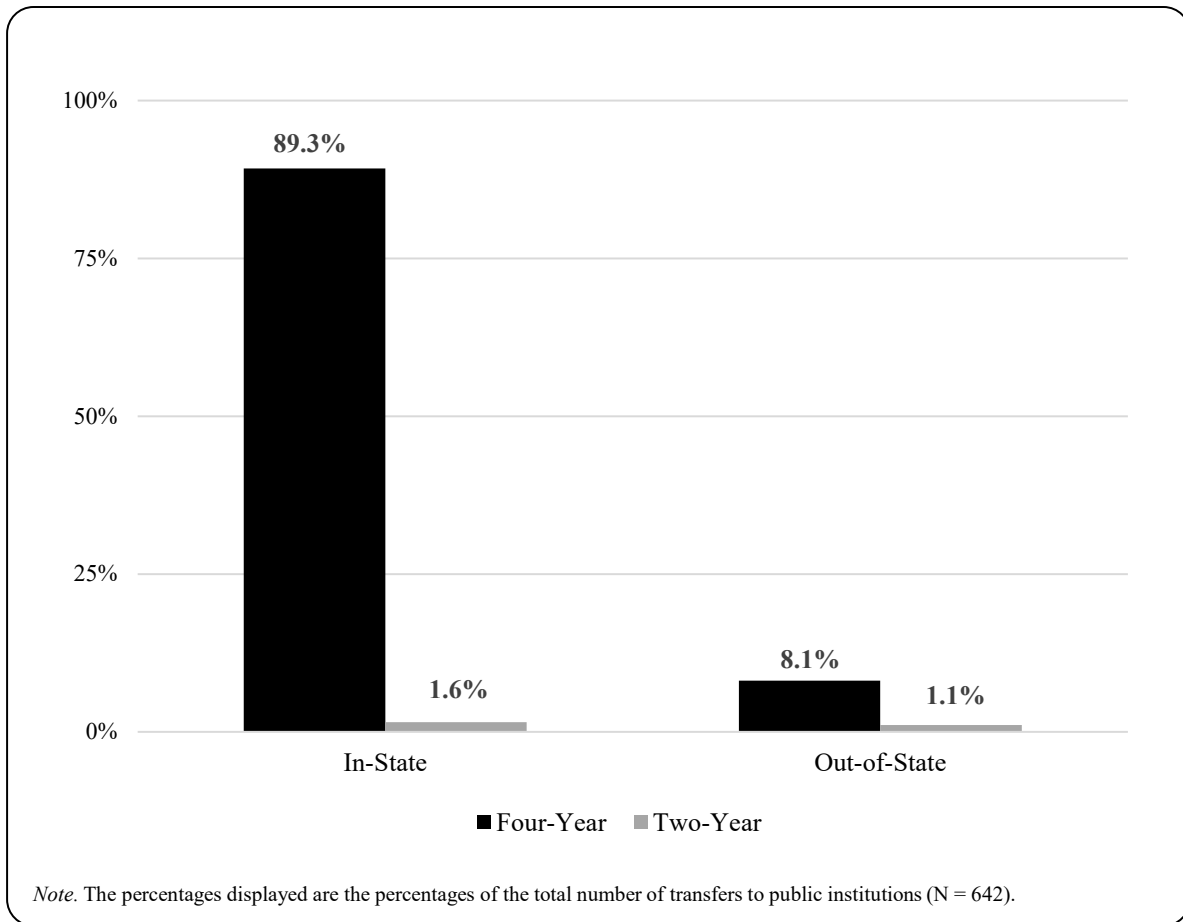

Figure 3. Percent of Transfers to Private Institutions by Institution Location and Type

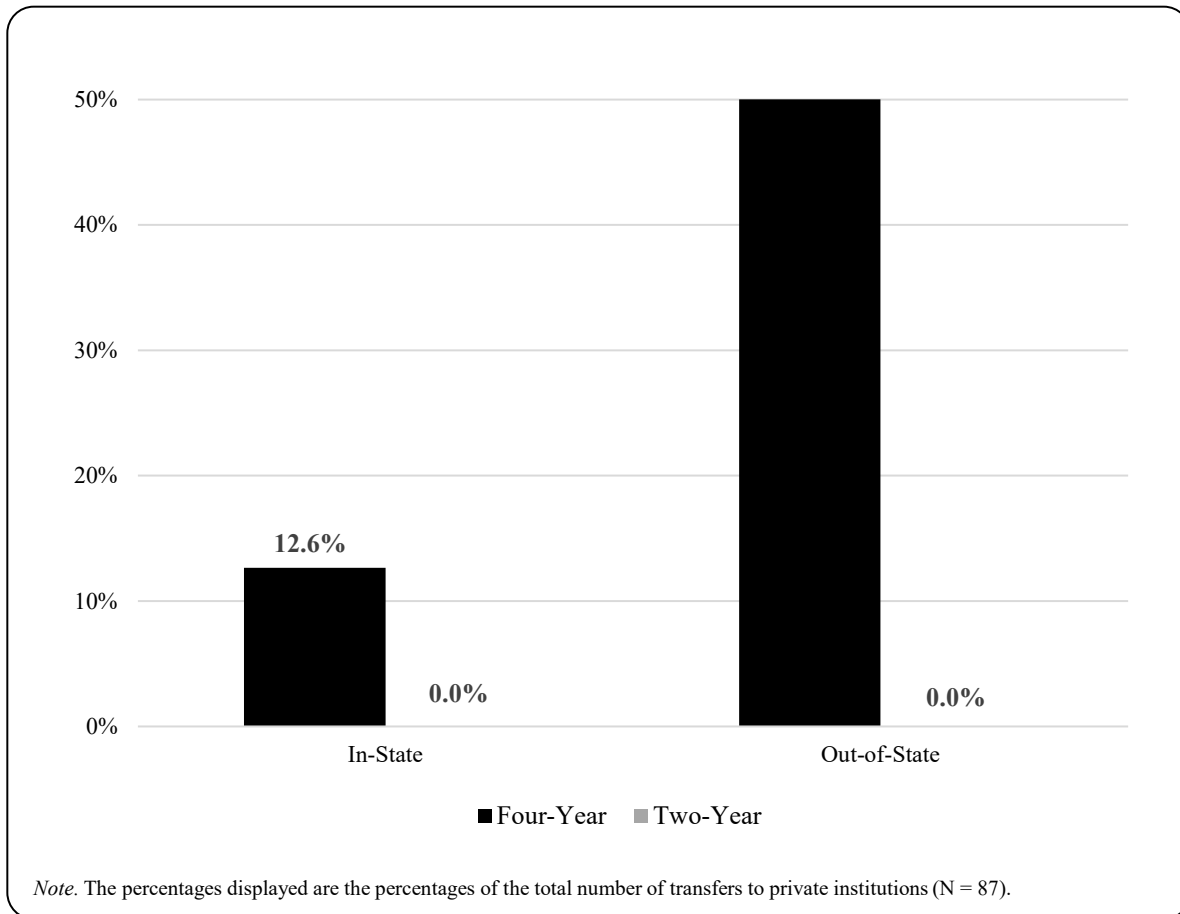
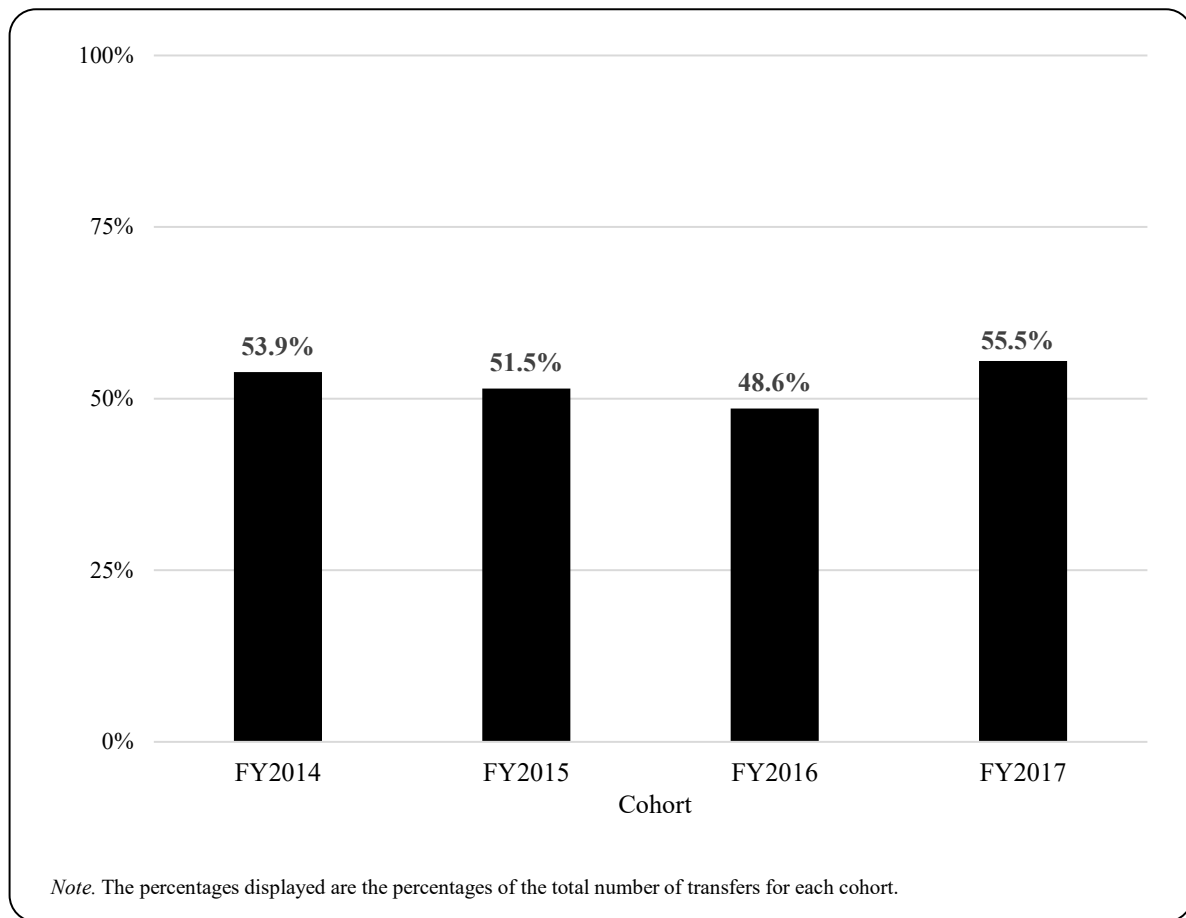
