- Over one-half (56.4%) of the students who transferred to two-year institutions enrolled at the following top five transfer institutions (the number of students transferred and percent of the total who transferred to two-year institutions is shown below) [p. 36]:
 - Prince George's Community College (30 students, 19.2%)
 - Anne Arundel Community College (28 students, 17.9%)
 - Community College of Baltimore County (17 students, 10.9%)
 - Northern Virginia Community College (9 students, 5.8%)
 - Eastern Gateway Community College (4 students, 2.6%)

- The programs with the top five largest transfers were:
 - Associate of Arts – General Studies (346 transfers)
 - Associate of Arts – Arts and Sciences (154 transfers)
 - Associate of Science – Business Administration (153 transfers)
 - Associate of Science – Nursing (98 transfers)
 - Certificate – General Studies Transfer Certificate (74 transfers)
