Executive Summary

Each year, the Planning, Institutional Effectiveness, and Research Department (PIER) prepares a report of transfer information of students who were enrolled at the College of Southern Maryland (CSM) during an academic year and transferred to another institution during the next academic year.

This report examines the cohort of CSM students who: 1) were enrolled on the census date of the Fall 2017, Spring 2018, and/or Summer 2018 terms; 2) had 12 or more cumulative credits earned by the end of the Summer 2018 term; and 3) transferred to another institution within the subsequent academic year. The report includes a summary of the transfer information, transfers by state and institution, transfers by CSM program of study, and rankings of transfer institutions.

Highlights of the Report

- Of the 6,562 students in the cohort, 26.5% (1,737) transferred to another institution within the subsequent academic year.
- When examining the students by the type of institution to which they transferred, 24.1% (1,581) transferred to four-year institutions, and 2.4% (156) transferred to two-year institutions. The majority of students who transferred, 72.3%, enrolled at an in-state institution.
- The 1,737 students who transferred went to 258 different institutions in 39 states, and the District of Columbia. Of those,
 - 1,581 students transferred to 200 different four-year institutions in 39 states and the District of Columbia; and
 - o 156 students transferred to 58 different two-year institutions in 21 states.
- More than two-thirds (71.1%) of the students who transferred to four-year institutions enrolled at the following top ten transfer institutions (the number of students transferred and percent of the total who transferred to four-year institutions is shown below) [p. 44]:
 - o University of Maryland University College (412 students, 26.1%)
 - o University of Maryland College Park (171 students, 10.8%)
 - o Towson University (154 students, 9.7%)
 - o Salisbury University (102 students, 6.5%)
 - o St. Mary's College of Maryland (87 students, 5.5%)
 - o University of Maryland Baltimore County (56 students, 3.5%)
 - o Frostburg State University (43 students, 2.7%)
 - o Notre Dame of Maryland University (40 students, 2.5%)
 - o Bowie State University (39 students, 2.5%)
 - o Chamberlain University (20 students, 1.3%)

- Over one-half (56.4%) of the students who transferred to two-year institutions enrolled at the following top five transfer institutions (the number of students transferred and percent of the total who transferred to two-year institutions is shown below) [p. 36]:
 - o Prince George's Community College (30 students, 19.2%)
 - o Anne Arundel Community College (28 students, 17.9%)
 - o Community College of Baltimore County (17 students, 10.9%)
 - o Northern Virginia Community College (9 students, 5.8%)
 - o Eastern Gateway Community College (4 students, 2.6%)

Figure 1. Percent of All Transfers by Institution Location and Type



Figure 2. Percent of Transfers to Public Institutions by Institution Location and Type



Figure 3. Percent of Transfers to Private Institutions by Institution Location and Type



