The Director of Payroll has been invited to the next meeting for further discussion to gain a better understanding of the salary advance process, and any State or Federal laws that may impact this policy.	
	Guidance CWC Co-Chairs Merranko and Patenaude thanked the members for their "good modeling" in requesting input outside their Councils. Commented on being mindful of the differences between Policies vs. Procedures, and Mandatory vs. Guidelines. Guidelines are more operational procedures; guidelines may be referenced in a policy but should not be included in the policy document.
