Promise Scholarship Checklist

The purpose of this checklist is to verify eligibility requirements prescribed by the State of Maryland. In order for a student to receive the Promise Scholarship, an applicant must submit **one item from category A, B, C and D** unless they have completed the FAFSA. For record keeping purposes, copies of each document must be attached to the student's application.

Students who have completed a FAFSA only need to submit documents from categories A and B.

A. Documents to prove eligibility for Maryland in-state Tuition. Individuals must be eligible for instate tuition at a Maryland institution to qualify for the Promise.

All documentation must be current and unexpired.

- Valid Maryland Driver's License
- Residential rental contract (apartment lease or other rental of real property)
- Mortgage account statement, deed, communication from the State Department of Assessment and Taxation or other proof of home ownership
- Maryland vehicle registration card or title
- Proof of Active Duty Military and Status.
- Proof of approval for Maryland DREAM Act (if selected, skip category D)

Note: In-State tuition rates are granted to students who reside in Maryland for a set period of time, have the ability to establish legal domicile in Maryland, or are stationed in Maryland.

- B. To be eligible, you must have completed your high school diploma in Maryland, including GED. Please provide documentation to prove you attended high school in the State. If you graduated HS or received your GED within the last 5 years, you must submit your final MD high school/GED transcript.
 - A copy of your Maryland High School Diploma, and/or
 - Official High school transcript.
- C. You must provide Federal documentation demonstrating you meet the income eligibility of \$100,000 for single filers or single-parent households, or combined income of \$150,000 for joint filing if married or residing in a two-parent household.
 - If dependent, submit a copy of your <u>AND</u> your parents' 2023 Federal tax transcript
 - If independent, submit a copy of your 2023 Federal tax transcript or
 - Copy of IRS Verification of Non-filing letter for 2023 Federal tax year
- D. Documents needed to prove that student is lawfully residing in the United States. (Provide one document from the list below).
 - United States Birth Certificate
 - Proof of Asylum Refugee status: I-94, I-94A, or Temporary Form I-551
 - Permanent Resident Card
 - United States Passport or Passport Card
 - Certificate of Naturalization
 - Certificate of Citizenship

Note: All citizenship documentation must be unexpired

Important Information You Should Know

- Students must be enrolled in a sequence of courses leading to licensure or certification. Current list of eligible workforce programs are included above. List is subject to change at any time.
- Available to MD Residents, graduates of MD high schools, and recipients of GED who qualify for in-state tuition, and active duty military residing in MD.
- Students may receive up to \$5,000 per academic year, not to exceed the cost of the program.
- Students may renew the scholarship up to 3 years after enrolling in a noncredit sequence.
- This is a last dollar scholarship, which means awards will calculated after all other Federal and State scholarships have been credited to the student's tuition.
- Any student who exceeds the allowed funding amount or number of program awards will be financially responsible for all associated costs that are deemed ineligible.
- Funds are available on a first come, first serve basis.
- Funds may only be used towards tuition and fees. Books and supplies are excluded.
- Students must provide their Social Security Number or Tax ID Number.
