

**ACADEMIC PROGRAM ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN  
COLLEGE OF SOUTHERN MARYLAND  
AND  
ST. MARY’S COLLEGE OF MARYLAND REGARDING TRANSFER FROM  
ASSOCIATE OF ARTS IN MUSIC TO BACHELOR OF ARTS IN PERFORMING  
ARTS: MUSIC**

This Academic Program Articulation Agreement (“Agreement”) is entered into by and between College of Southern Maryland (the “Sending Institution”) and St. Mary’s College of Maryland (the “Receiving Institution”) (collectively, the “Institutions”) to facilitate the transfer of academic credits from Associate of Arts in Music for the completion of Bachelor of Arts in Performing Arts: Music (the “Program(s)”).

**A. Qualifying Students**

This Agreement pertains to the transfer of “Qualifying Students”, *i.e.*, those students who:


1. Have successfully completed an Associate of Art in Music with a concentration in Music at the Sending Institution;
2. Are enrolled in College of Southern Maryland, in good standing;
3. Met the minimum grade requirements as outlined in the SMCM Catalog at <https://catalog.smcm.edu>; and
4. Completed the following coursework at College of Southern Maryland outlined below. As part of the transfer credit evaluation process, SMCM will evaluate courses/credits earned through Advanced Placement (AP), College-Level Examination Program (CLEP), International Baccalaureate (IB) programs, military credit, or other sources of prior learning credit. SMCM policies for awarding prior learning credit will supersede prior learning credit that may have been awarded by a prior institution. 5. Complete at least 128 credits total in order to graduate from St. Mary’s College of Maryland.
